New Air Purification System

REME HALO does not need the pollutants to travel to the air handler for UV treatment or filtration. It sends out ionized aggressive advanced oxidizers into the room to destroy the pollutants at the source, in the air and on surfaces. Here are some of the test results from an independent test facility.

- Kills 99% of sneeze germs within 3 feet
